

# CANADA QUICK START



## **FAMILY SEARCH** <http://www.familysearch.org/eng/>

### **SEARCH FOR YOUR ANCESTORS.**

Enter all known information about your deceased ancestor. Click SEARCH.

### **SEARCH ALL DATA BASES.**

In the INTERNATIONAL GENEALOGICAL INDEX (IGI), if your desired name was extracted, a Batch number will be at the bottom of the record. By clicking the Batch # twice, you can find the original record.

### **FAMILY HISTORY LIBRARY CATALOG (FHLC)**

1. Do a **PLACE SEARCH** by town. Click on your **LOCATION** name.
2. Look in "Related Places" to find smaller localities.
3. Select Civil Registration, Church Records, Census, Vital Records, Land Records. Etc.
4. **VIEW FILM** Notes to find the dates you want to get the number of the film that has the information.
5. Look to see if the film is available in the Mesa RFHC.  
It can be ordered from Salt Lake City for a minimal fee.

1. Census, baptisms, burials, marriages, civil and church records in CANADA.
2. Search more in other provinces, France and United States for your ancestor.
